AMOUNT: \$1,500.00 / ea.

Four (4) scholarship awards available for 2018.

- (1) AWARD: Spouse of <u>active duty Navy</u> or Marine Corps personnel of the Wing, Support Detachments, or in-garrison commands posted to MCAS, Yuma.
- (1) AWARD: Graduating high school senior parent or grandparent that is either active duty or a veteran of our National Sea Services (US Navy, US Marine Corps, US Coast Guard or US-flagged Merchant marine).
- (2) AWARDs: MCJROTC or US Naval Sea Cadets graduating high school. If only 1 candidate is eligible, an additional award may be reassigned to HS graduating senior.

ELGIBILITY: Deadline for acceptance - delivered to committee no later than 5pm, March 30th.

- Be a United States Citizen
- HS students must be a senior scheduled to graduate from the 12th grade at the end of the current school year that application is submitted.
 - Applicant must have a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better grades 10-12.
- ACDU Spouses must be preparing for or are currently fully matriculated.
- JROTC / NSCC cadets must be a senior scheduled to graduate from the 12th grade at the end
 of the current school year that application is submitted.
 - Applicant must have a grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or better grades 10-12.
- Eligible schools of applicant to attend are any accredited 4 year college or university, 2 year college or 1 yr. vocational/technical school.

HOW TO APPLY:

- Complete the application form and all information requested below.
- HS Students: Include three (3) letters of recommendation. At least two (2) must be from HS faculty (unless home schooled – 3 letters still apply).
- HS Students: Include verification of grade point average (GPA) from teacher/counselor on official school letter head stationary.
- ACDU Spouse: Acceptance letter or registrar record of full college matriculation (12 semester credits).
 Previous years GPA (HS or College) official record.
- ACDU Spouse: 3 letters of recommendation.
- Include typed list of awards, community service, and school activities.
- Include one typewritten essay (double spaced, 1"margins - 4 sides):
