


#### Happy Birthday, Sailors & Marines!





#### DEC 7th, 1941 (PEARL HARBOR DAY) CEREMONY



On December 7th, 2020 - American Legion Post 19 opened its doors to host it's annual Pearl Harbor Day Remembrance Event. Keynote speaker this year was our own Council President, 'doc' Hager (CAPT, USNR ret). This years theme was 'Recognizing our Pearl Harbor Survivors'.

Remarks Excerpt: "Our Pearl Survivors and WWII veterans are of a generation that were born into Great Depression hard times only to be faced a decade later with threats intended to bring about the destruction of their nation and personal freedom throughout the world. They entered a global war that saw over 450,000 of their fellow service personnel pay the ultimate price; emerging victorious. Today, years later in a quiet conversation, they will readily acknowledge the courage of others but are reluctant to admit their own. They deny that they themselves did anything noble. "I just did my duty" is what they usually say. You see, no true hero actually believes himself to be one. They truly are our *Greatest Generation*".


